Monthly Reflection

Reflexión del Mes

Dear Parishioners:

The month of September begins straight away with a holiday that we call "Labor Day". This has been a national holiday for over 125 years in the U.S.A. Americans celebrate this holiday in commemoration of the dignity of just labor laws, particularly to allow for labor unions and good working conditions in the labor force in America. This holiday was made a national holiday signed by President Grover Cleveland in 1894. However, most Americans see it as the last summer holiday before beginning the school year; it is always the first Monday of September.

In September, the new school year begins as well as our Catechism classes; for the first year it will be on Tuesday, Sept. 10 and second year on Thursday, Sept. 12 for catechesis for children preparing for the sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. This year's confirmation for Year II children will be scheduled on May 15, 2025 and the First Holy Communion date will be scheduled on Saturday, May 10, 2025.

In this month there are many wonderful feast days coming up such as the feast day of Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is on September 8, 2024. The Feast of St. Nicholas of Tolentine, patron saint for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, Our Lady of Sorrows and The Holy Cross and many more. It is also our month for our Parish Kermes which will begin on September 7th after the 4:00 p.m. Vigil Mass in Spanish and continue on Sunday September 8 throughout the whole day.

I am grateful to all the parish leaders and parishioners who made the Celebration of Our Lady of Czestochowa last week a delightful success. It was a great opportunity to enjoy the Feast Day as well as delicious Polish food, music and festivities. I look forward with hope and joy for the blessings of September and ask God to greatly bless and unite our parish with a spirit of Mission as we give thanks to God for the Holy Eucharist that feeds us and sustains us every day of our lives.

El mes de septiembre comienza de inmediato con un día festivo que llamamos "Día del Trabajo". Este ha sido un día festivo nacional durante más de 125 años en los EE. UU. Los estadounidenses celebran esta fiesta en conmemoración de la dignidad de las leyes laborales justas, en particular para permitir los sindicatos y las buenas condiciones laborales en la fuerza laboral en Estados Unidos. Esta fiesta fue declarada fiesta nacional por el presidente Grover Cleveland en 1894. Sin embargo, la mayoría de los estadounidenses lo ven como las últimas vacaciones de verano antes de comenzar el año escolar; siempre es el primer lunes de septiembre.

En septiembre, comienza el nuevo año escolar, así como nuestras clases de Catecismo; durante el primer año será el martes 10 de septiembre y el segundo año el jueves 12 de septiembre para la catequesis de los niños que se preparan para los sacramentos de la Sagrada Comunión y la Confirmación. Este año la confirmación para los niños de Year II será programada para el 15 de mayo de 2025 y la fecha de la Primera Comunión será programada para el sábado 10 de mayo de 2025.

En este mes se avecinan muchos días festivos maravillosos, como la fiesta del Nacimiento de la Santísima Virgen María, que es el 8 de septiembre de 2024. La fiesta de San Nicolás de Tolentino, santo patrono de las Benditas Almas del Purgatorio, Nuestra Señora de los Dolores y la Santa Cruz y muchas más. También es nuestro mes para nuestra Kermes Parroquial, que comenzará el 7 de septiembre después de la Misa de Vigilia de las 4:00 p.m. en español y continuará el domingo 8 de septiembre durante todo el día.

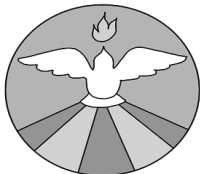

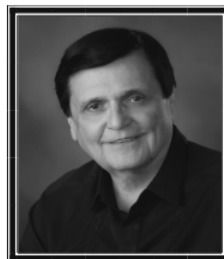

An individual may offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit ones soul. A donation of \$10 is requested for each mass intention.

Offering Envelopes

The parish envelope system is an easy and organized way of making your financial contributions to the parish on a regular basis. This system enables us to record the contributions and issue year-end statements for tax purposes. (Such statements can ONLY be issued to those who use the envelopes.) We count on regular use of the envelopes to pay for the upkeep of the church, to help plan for the needs of the parish and to help set realistic goals.

As another option, we suggest our Online Giving program. Online Giving allows participants to donate a recurring contribution that is automatically transferred from your checking or savings account, or even credit card, on a weekly or monthly basis, and you select your own billing date. This Program can be utilized for your Sunday contributions, as well as any Holy Day Collection, and all Special and Diocesan collections. The Online Giving Program is free of charge for parishioners.

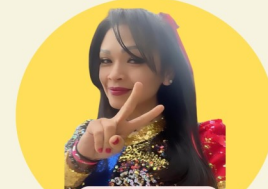

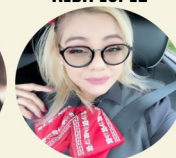

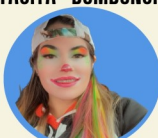
